2. Declaration of Interest

3. Decision Paper - 2025 Tournament Entry Fees

The Tournament Convenor introduced the 2025 Tournament Entry Fees paper and the Head Professional referenced the main points of each individual tournament and entry fee.

Craws Nest Tassie

The entry of £450.00 was agreed by the committee. The STH entry price of £200.00 was also approved by the committee.

Senior Open, Cant Cup and Women's Senior Open

The entry fee of £40.00 was agreed by the committee. The STH entry fee of £20.00 was also approved by the committee

Junior Open

It was recommended to continue to provide this event free of charge to competitors.

Northern Ladies – 18-hole and 54-hole events

The entry fee of £65.00 for both events was agreed by the committee. The STH entry fee of £20.00 was also approved by the committee

The committee members in attendance were supportive of the decision paper and via emails from those not in attendance, it was agreed for the paper to go to the next full board meeting for approval.

4. Northern Ladies 54-Hole Event Update

The Head Professional updated the committee regarding the Northern Ladies Championship for 2025 and how the event will become a 54-hole World Amateur Ranking event and will be added to the Scottish Golf Women's Order of Merit for 2025. CGL has worked closely with the Scottish Golf Events and Performance Teams to find a suitable date for the event which will hopefully attract Scottish elite amateur women to participate. The Northern Ladies will still retain an 18-hole championship for higher handicap players or players who do not wish to participate in the 54-hole event.

5. Any Other Competent Business

Links Championship Participation

The Head Professional raised a point of discussion regarding the participation numbers in the Links Championships (Gents, Ladies, Ladies Rosebowl, Junior and Nicoll Cup) and asked if it would be considered to change the format and subsequent finals date for these events to attract more participants. After discussion, the Head Professional agreed to create a proposal for the sub-committee to consider for approval at a future date.
